Precision Diagnostics, L.L.C. respects the privacy of its customers and other visitors to this website. Thus, we created this Website Privacy Policy (this "Privacy Policy") to inform you about our information practices. This Privacy Policy applies only to this website and not to any other websites that you may be able to access from this website. What Information Do We Collect?

- We collect information from you when you voluntarily submit information on this website, send an email from this website, place an order or submit an inquiry such as email, or participate in another website function or feature.
- When you submit an inquiry or contact our Customer Service department, we may ask you for your name, email address, mailing address, phone number, or other information. You may, however, visit our website without providing such information.
- Like many websites, we use "cookies" or other technology to enhance your experience and gather information about visitors and visits to our websites. Please refer to the "Do we use 'cookies'?" section below for information about cookies and related technology and how we use them.
- By accessing our website, our internet servers automatically record information your internet browser sends when you visit a website (a "Log"). How Do We Use Your Information?

We may use the information we collect about you in ways described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy and in the following ways:

Use Of "Cookies"

Yes. Cookies are small files that a website or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (unless you set your browser to reject cookies) that enables the website's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and store certain information. They may be used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current website activity, which may enable us to provide you with improved services. We also may use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about website traffic and website interaction so that we can offer better website experiences and tools in the future.
